The Quality Chemist will report to the Quality Manager and is overall responsible for improving the quality control.</p> <p>Main Responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop and utilize SQC and SPC in order to improve the quality control. • Lead and participate in root cause and failure analysis investigations associated with production issues, analytical issues, customer complaint investigations or manufacturing errors. • Oversee, write, edit and approve quality investigations conducted as a result of manufacturing errors and/or customer complaints • Lead and participate in development projects related to quality issues. • Maintain and audit quality management systems for deficiency identification and improvements. • Assist with training and help with continuous improvement projects across the plant. Continuous improvement is a major key responsibility for this role. • Handle specifications, inventories etc in the SAP-system, and act as a back up for the sister refinery in Oulu. • As a backup resource for QC, conduct routine and non-routine analysis.
