Major Roles & Responsibilities

The Senior Tax Analyst will conduct tax research and perform compliance monitoring under the direction of the Director of Global Tax.

Major Roles & Responsibilities:

- Compiling, preparing, and analyzing international, federal and state income and franchise tax returns, ensuring accurate and timely filing to minimize assessments and penalties
- Managing the preparation of federal and state income tax filings, estimated tax payments and extensions
- Leading the gathering and preparation of documentation related to Accounting for Income Taxes under ASC 740
- Preparing and assessing the international components of consolidated U.S. federal income tax returns, including Forms 1118, 5471, 5713, 8858, 8865 and related elections and consolidated return statements
- Managing and coordinating the resolution process for state and federal tax notices and tax audits with various federal, state, and local governmental agencies
- Analyzing fixed asset data and maintaining tax depreciation records
- Conducting research on international, federal, state, and local laws and regulations, as well as
 proactively monitoring legislative changes to ensure compliance
- Participating in, and supporting, global tax planning, as well as involvement in special projects such as mergers and acquisitions (M&A)
- Documenting, reviewing, and testing the performance of internal controls and procedures for SOX compliance testing
